### YOUR ROLE ON BOARD

We are seeking a commitment for a period of 3 years with an option to serve up to 6 years. Dance Limerick is a registered charity, and this is a voluntary, unpaid position. Travel expenses will be paid. Previous experience of being on a Board is not essential induction and training is provided. The Board meets 4 times a year plus the AGM with sub-group meetings outside of Board meetings. Meeting may be held online. Board members are expected to contribute to the ongoing development of the organisation and attend performance events where possible.

# DANCE LIMERICK BACKGROUND

Established in 2013, our ambition is to inspire curiosity, creativity, and connection through dance. We believe dance empowers and enriches us as individuals, as communities and as a society. Our ambition is for Dance Limerick to be a place for dance and a hub of creativity for our artists and for all those with whom we engage. Through dance we support artists and the public alike to be curious, to be creative and to connect with each other and to what matters in the world around us.

We develop an ambitious annual programme of professional development and public events where people can enjoy and reflect on dance and engage with our community of wonderful artists. We collaborate with artists representing diverse practices and our aim is to place them at the centre of what we do. Our ambition is to ensure that our artists are supported and that we, in some small way, contribute to their achievements.

These programmes are developed by consulting widely and by collaborating with experienced choreographers and dance artists to devise meaningful and imaginative programmes.

While we are based in the heart of Limerick city, our focus is also national and international. To this end, we collaborate regularly with Dance Ireland, Firkin Crane, Galway Dance and Tipperary Dance. We are members of the European Dance House Network (EDN), and the Aerowaves Network of dance presenters. Through these forums, we exchange practice and information with our national and international peers which allows us to contribute to both the national and international dance ecology.

Our annual programmes for artists and audiences include.

 An annual Associate Dance Artist in collaboration with the Irish World Academy of Music and Dance at University of Limerick. The Artist is supported with studio time to carry out a personal work programme over the course of 12 months, and receives a seed commission for the development of new work.

- The Residency Programmes supports up to 10 artists/ensembles annually, with studio space, accommodation and the opportunity to interact with local peers and to gain critical feedback on work in development.
- A professional development progrmame of classes by local and visiting artists along with masterclasses, workshops and seminars by leading artists working in dance, performance and other complementary disciplines.
- Step Up Dance Project for recently graduated dancers, which aims to bridge the gap between dance education and professional practice.
- The What Next Dance Festival showcasing the work of early and mid career artists.
- Light Moves Festival of Dance & New Media Arts
- DL Bridge a programme of imaginative interventions and projects with communities of place or interest
- Inspirational performances allowing artists see the work of national and international peers, and audiences to see professional dance in Limerick.
